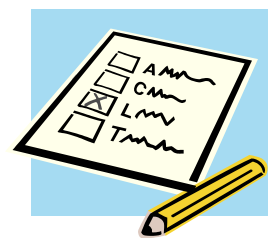

## **Cook's Corner**

### **Hot Cocoa Mix** (taken from Dillard's Southern Living Christmas Cookbook)

**Give a friend the delightful gift of hot cocoa or keep it for your family.**

Recipe:

- 1 cup powdered non-dairy coffee creamer
- 1 cup sifted powdered sugar
- ½ cup miniature marshmallows
- ¼ cup cocoa
- ¼ cup mint chocolate morsels

Combine all ingredients; store in an airtight container. Yield: 2 1/3 cups.

**Directions for Gift Card: Combine 1/3 cup Hot Cocoa Mix and 2/3 cup boiling water, stirring well. Yield, about 1 cup.**
